

TransBaltic in a nutshell



- Strategic project in the transnational Baltic Sea Region Programme 2007-2013 (ERDF Obj.3)
- Duration: 2009-2012, budget of 5.4 MEUR
- 50 financial and associated partners from 11 BSR countries
- Area of interest: whole BSR + Central Asia + China/India
- Implementation tool for the EU Baltic Sea Strategy
- Meeting place for public and private stakeholders to discuss transport and regional development challenges
- Umbrella over transport corridor projects (macro view)
