

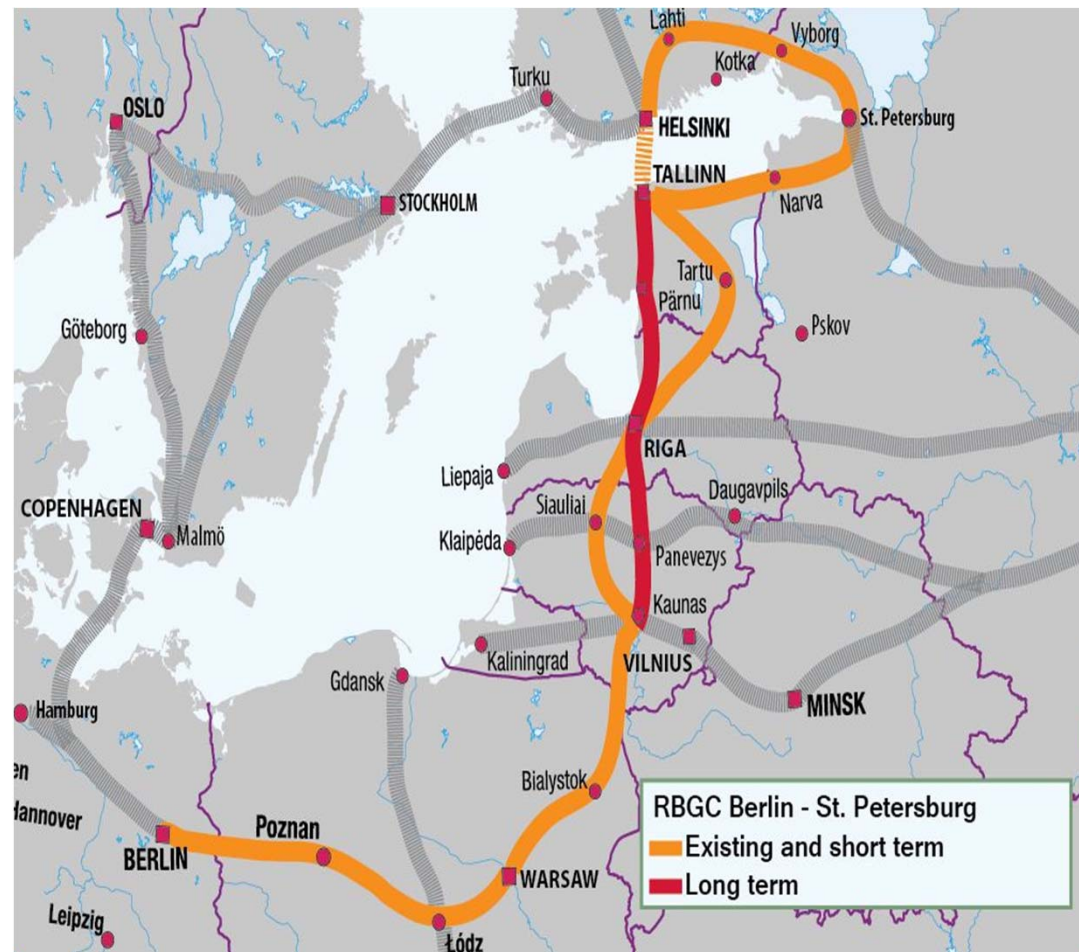

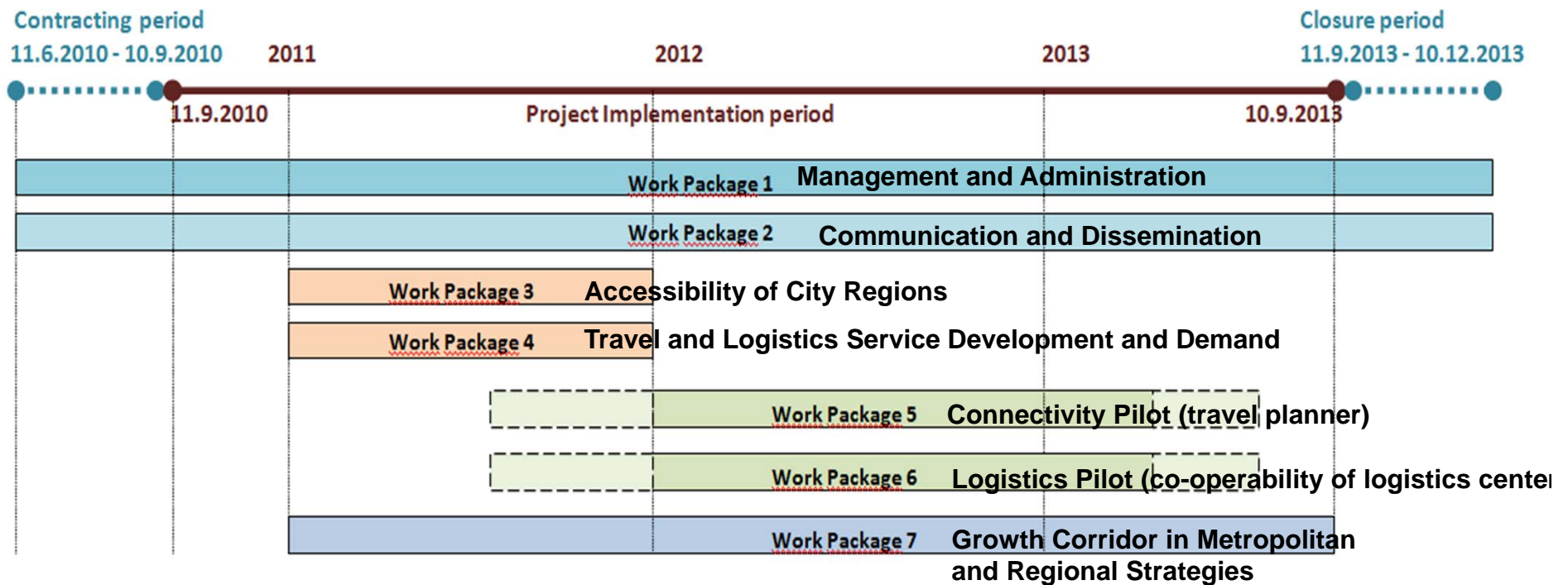

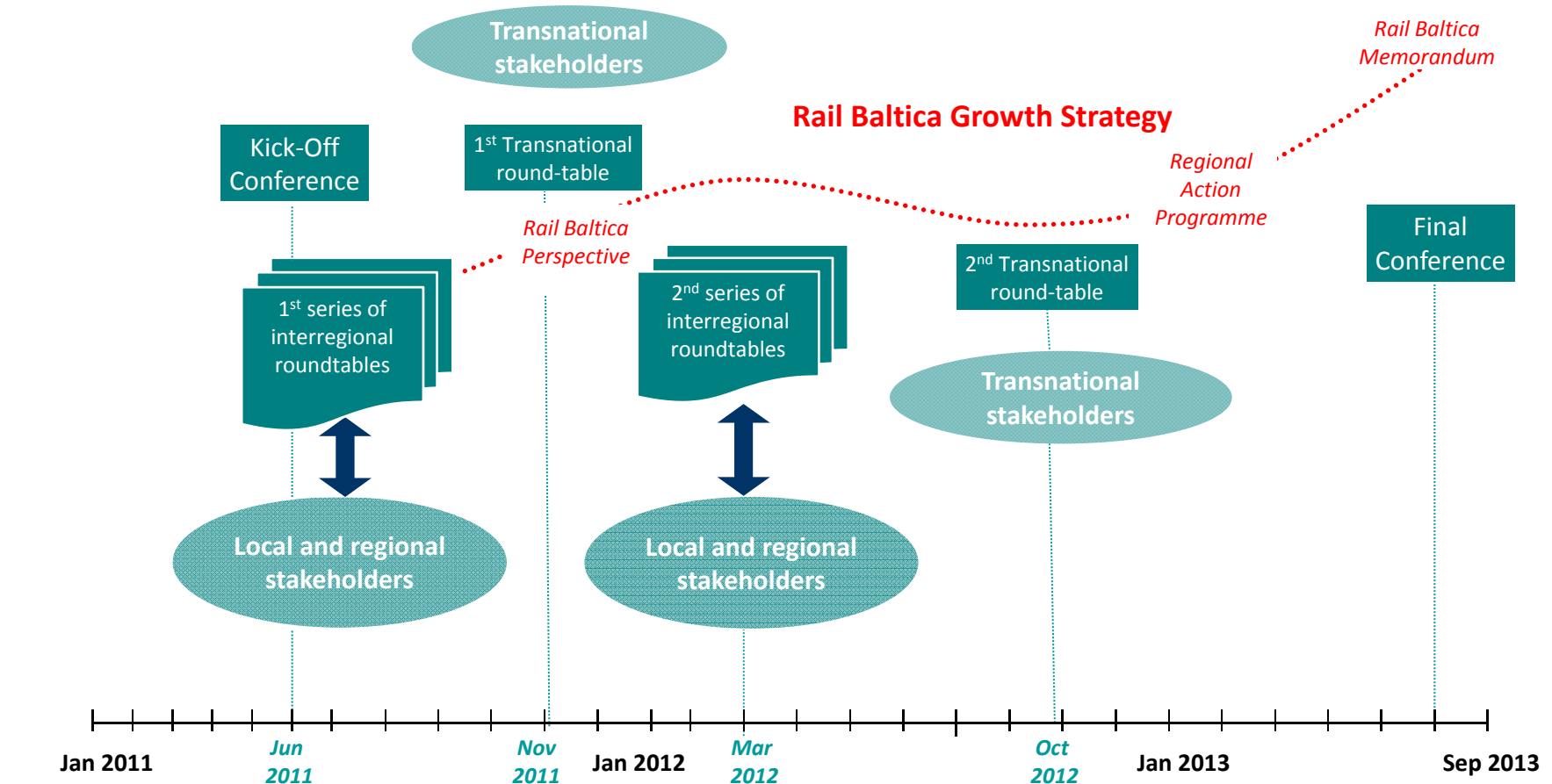

- Decision map of the public sector towards RB

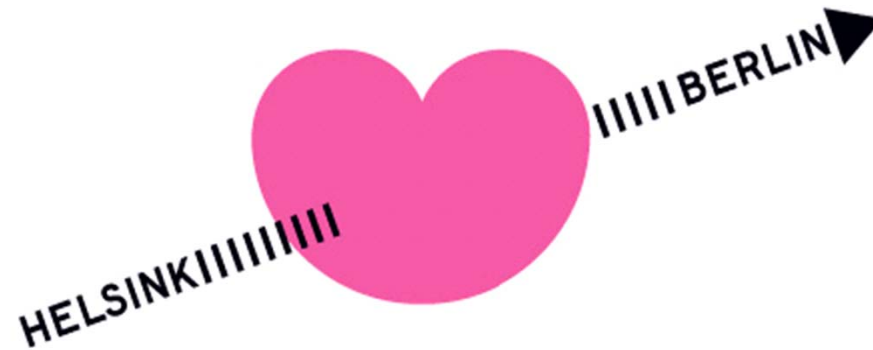
### **WP 4 – research of private sector**
