The main goal of the EU new transport policy

To develop system which supports development of European economy, increases competitiveness and provides high quality mobility services, at the same time using resources more effectively



The EC's position on the future of transport planning

- Transport is viewed as a <u>basic necessity</u> in the context of any other priority / sector.
- Transport sector needs to be seen <u>integrated rather than</u> <u>separately</u> roads, railways, air transport, sea transport; the emphasis on the synergy / co-modality
